An interdisciplinary degree program is a program of study that has been derived from two or more academic disciplines. Such programs teach the intellectual approaches, knowledge bases, and working methods of multiple disciplines and how they can be applied to these disciplines in different ways. This thereby provides a broader educational perspective and a deeper and more complex learning experience for students. Students enrolled in interdisciplinary degree programs take major courses in multiple departments, which exposes them to a variety of ways of thinking and builds valuable skills of communication and synthesis across disciplines.
