Students with majors and minors in World Languages and Cultures have been successful in careers in education, international business, non-profit agencies, the viticulture industry, software and Internet-related services, and government. Others have attended graduate and professional schools in various fields, including languages, literatures, and cultures, applied linguistics, international business, translation and interpretation, education, psychology, law, and medicine. Our graduates have also been selected to teach in secondary schools in Spain (North American Language and Culture Assistants) and France (Teaching Assistant Program in France). In collaboration with the Cal Poly School of Education, we also prepare students for the California single-subject World Languages Teaching Credential. Finally, we work closely with our students to integrate junior- or senior-level education abroad experiences, internships or service-learning experiences in the U.S. or another country, or equivalent professional-level hands-on experiences (with departmental approval) as part of their total capstone experiences.

Program Learning Objectives

- 1. Learn to communicate effectively in Spanish and other target languages through speaking, listening, reading, and writing in authentic situations.
- 2. Develop communicative and intercultural competency so that they can work productively both as individuals and in collaboration with others.
- 3. Gain perspective on cultural and historical achievements in the target-language cultures as well as on relevant issues of diversity.
- 4. Cultivate awareness of ethical and professional perspectives that reflect linguistic and cultural heritage.
- 5. Think critically and creatively using Spanish and other target languages and negotiate meaning between the target language(s) and English.
- 6. Develop the life-long ability to evaluate ways in which language and culture provide perspective on the larger world of the arts, sciences, and technology.
